

DAAD Strategic Partnership Grant - Hochschule Darmstadt 2015-2018

Funding options for lecturers:

Short term lecturer (1 month):

1 (or more) of your faculty members can stay and teach at h_da for one month each year. Here we have a total of 8 scholarships for all partners until 2018.
Funding: 700 Euros travel + 2000 Euros scholarship

Long term visiting lecturer (6 months):

1 (or more) of your faculty members can stay at h_da for about half a year. There is a total of 7 scholarships until December 2018.
Funding: 700 Euros travel + 2000 Euros scholarship per month

Faculty and staff – important events and opportunities in 2015/2016:

Student groups – short term study at h_da (faculty-led program)

The group visits are meant to give your students and faculty an idea what teaching and studying at h_da is like – and how easy-going life in Darmstadt is. Students will be welcomed at h_da departments relevant for their fields of study and be able to participate in lectures and project work. They will get to know our professors and potential fellow students. And there will be an excursion and fun program.

You can send faculty led groups of up to 10 students for one week. We have funding for 8 groups in total (until 2018), so please let us know about your plans.
Funding for students: 700 Euros travel + 50 Euros per day for each student
Funding for faculty: 89 Euros per day

Staff training / Int. Week: November 30th – December 4th 2015 or sometime in 2016

We would like to host one of your administrators for one week (or more) to exchange ideas and give insight into our daily work. A nice opportunity would be our Erasmus Week with many guests from all over Europe. - Additional staff training could take place at any point in 2016.

Funding: 89 Euros per day
Duration: 1 week
Total of scholarships: 8 (until 2018)

H_da research meeting: December 1st 2015

On Dec. 1st h_da faculty members will present their current research projects and publications. There will be poster sessions and talks. Maybe we could find matching partners in different academic field and bring them together on that occasion. I would need your help identifying faculty members on your side who might be interested.

Funding: each person 89 Euros per day
Total of scholarships: 8 (until 2018)
