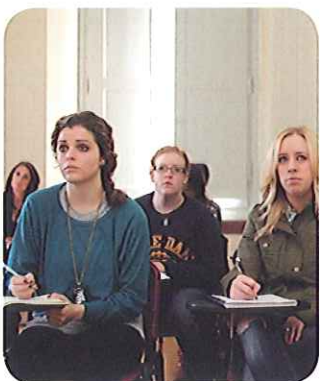
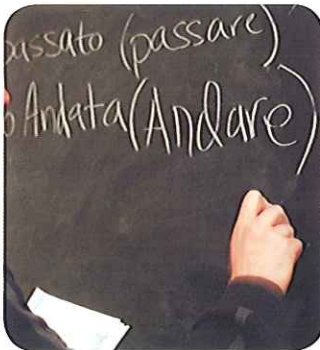

Through almost forty years of experience and research in teaching Italian language and culture, Lorenzo de' Medici provides high quality instruction in all four language acquisition skills - listening, speaking, reading and writing. LdM uses an interactive and participatory approach to learning the language and culture, encouraging students through tandem conversation exchanges with their Italian peers and role play. Weekly seminars on Italian culture and society, and guided tours to places of cultural interest such as museums, monuments and artisan's workshops are offered in some courses as a supplementary learning experience. Courses feature a full range of levels and formula (from three- to sixteen-credit). LdM is a proud member of the Association of Schools Teaching Italian as a Second Language (ASILS) and of the International Association of Language Centers (IALC).

A rich variety of special cultural courses taught entirely in Italian develop linguistic skills such as translation and offer further bridges to Italian culture, history, art, politics, and communities. Students may choose courses in each of the following fields: Italian literature, civilization, film and art. Focused topics such as mass media in Italy, Italian literature for children and young adults, and politics in Italy today, may be pursued in Italian. Another course that joins language and experiential learning involves service activities, completely in Italian, at venues not often accessible to students, such as charitable organizations and public schools. The courses reflect the LdM conviction that language skills and cultural knowledge must reinforce each other in a study abroad experience.
