Amount: \$7,500-\$15,000. A sophomore Goldwater recipient will receive up to \$7,500 in both junior and senior years. A junior recipient will receive up to \$7,500 for just the senior year.

Amount: Up to \$20,000 for 25-52 weeks (preferred), up to \$10,000 for 12-24 weeks, up to \$8,000 for 8-11 weeks (STEM majors only).

Amount: Up to \$24,000 for 37-52 weeks abroad (preferred), up to \$20,000 for 25-36 weeks abroad (preferred), up to \$12,000 for 12-24 weeks, and up to \$12,000 for domestic language study (optional).
